



Elmer the Elephant

You will need: An empty milk carton, scissors, squares of tissue paper, PVA glue, paint brush (to spread the glue), googly eyes or a black marker.

Imagining that the handle of the milk carton is the trunk, and the four corners of the milk carton are the legs, draw four arches between them. Use your scissors to cut out the arches as well as the base of the milk carton.

Now that you have your Elmer shape, start glueing the tissue paper onto his body using any colours you want. Once you have all the tissue paper stuck on, put a thin layer of glue on the top to make sure it sticks properly.

Leave your elephant to dry overnight and in the morning trim any edges of tissue paper. Finally draw or stick two little eyes on either side of the trunk and, “Then you have an Elmer and he isn’t at all ordinary”.
